This was in addition to the individual session for children with C.P, mental retardation; slow learning, Down syndrome, autism...etc, in the local community rehabilitation center at southern camps. Moreover, health education and raising awareness for parents, school staffs and community workers were as integral part of my work as occupational therapist.

2010-2013 I worked at Bethlehem Arab Society for Rehabilitation – Dura Rehabilitation Unit, mainly as occupational therapist with both technical and administrative duties. My role as occupational therapist was including several tasks such as evaluating different disabilities and clarify areas of functional impairment; prioritizing work with beneficiaries based on the nature of disability, age group, gender; setting the long and short term goals, building individual treatment plans and implementing them; following-up the treatment plans, monitoring beneficiaries progress and examining the extent to which the goals are achieved; re-evaluating treatment plans and writing the relevant reports.

2013-2016 I worked in Nahdet Bent Al Reef Charitable society as occupational therapist and a rehabilitation center coordinator. I was the leader of the technical team at the center. I held many technical and administrative responsibilities; particularly, work plans, fundraising, relationship with other stakeholders, international and national NGOs, as well as my roles towards the patients and their families.
